



# The Manchester Crematorium

## **Terms and Conditions of Rose Memorials**

- 1.** The memorial will remain the property of The Manchester Crematorium Limited.
- 2.** The Crematorium will accept the responsibility to maintain, preserve and tend it for a period of not less than five years. Should the plant die during this period, then it will be replaced at no charge. In the event of any alteration in the layout of the gardens, the Crematorium shall be at liberty to move the plant to an alternative site.
- 3.** If a replacement is required, The Manchester Crematorium cannot guarantee that the same variety will be planted.
- 4.** At the end of each dedication period the lease may be renewed for a further five year period. The Crematorium will attempt to contact the lessee at the last known address advising them of the cost of re-dedication, but it will remain the responsibility of the lessee to ensure the renewal fee is paid.  
Notice of changes of address must be made in writing to the Crematorium offices no less than eight weeks before the renewal date.
- 5.** For means of identification, a name plate bearing the name(s) and appropriate dates only will be supplied by the Crematorium and displayed by the memorial.
- 6.** In order to avoid untidiness in the gardens, any unauthorized labels, pots, or plants placed near the memorial will be removed without warning at a time convenient to the Crematorium.
- 7.** The memorial will exist whilst in good condition, regardless of whether it is dedicated or otherwise. The Crematorium reserves the right to decide when a plant requires replacement.
- 8.** The Crematorium reserves the right to amend or cancel any or all the conditions without giving reasons at any time without giving notice of such amendment or cancellation.
- 9.** The Crematorium will replace any label that is incorrect, provided it is reported within the first six months. After this time labels will be charged at the standard rate.
